DESCRIPTION	<p>This Side Event intends to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Bring together legal experts, national and subnational authorities that are interested in joining the legal process initiated by ECLAC, that is aimed at signing a binding agreement for Latin American countries in establishing a common principle for planning and land management. b) Establish a platform to identify the challenges and opportunities, by creation of a Latin American agreement on urbanization backed by the New Urban Agenda. c) To propose a roadmap to follow for the development, approval and implementation of a Latin American Urban binding agreement focused on recognition, security and development of Rights in the City. d) Establishing a permanent working group with CEPAL and the Urban Legislation Unit of UN-Habitat to deepen the content of the proposals arising from the Event that is proposed.
