DESCRIPTION	A three-day training course for local government officials back to back with the actual PrepCom3. As local and regional governments are now being entrusted with leading their cities towards achieving the Sustainable Development Goals, it is highly relevant to provide them with a better understanding of financing mechanisms. With this in mind, CDIA in cooperation with PT Sarana Multi Infrastruktur (SMI), and UCLG-ASPAC organizes this training course as a forum to learn about financing modalities and infrastructure funding sources, engage in interactive sessions, and exchange ideas through hands-on case studies in Asia. The 3-day training is composed of three main modules, looking at an Introduction To The Linking to Finance Lingo: building the Know How to Talk About Financing, an exploration of the Asian and local Financing/Financier Map: enhancing the Know Who To Talk To, and finally an Interactive Case Study Exercise on Investment Finance. The course is geared towards mid to senior level financing and managing city officials, as well as intermediary institutions and agencies supporting cities in linking their infrastructure investment projects to finance.
