Background information on the event (themes, issues, context).	Rebuilding the City Many cities include sectors in their core areas that are under utilized, but whose vocations are destined to change in order to meet the need for renewed and diversified urban activities for economic and housing purposes. The intention to density urban activities associated with public transit serves to favour public interventions aimed at transforming some of these sectors in order to better meet housing and employment needs. These operations are the concrete expressions of the challenge in rebuilding the city upon itself. These sectors undergoing transformation are the laboratory for the New Urban Agenda. They are the sites for the implementation of new financing tools and partnerships focused on innovation. These rebuilding operations put the emphasis on public transport, affordable housing and real-estate strategies, related to public participation.
Concise summary of the event proceedings, including key points discussed	The moderator gave a brief introduction on the theme. Each of the 5 speakers presented the case of the city they represent, giving concrete examples of actions and interventions going on in their city according with the challenge of rebuilding or with the transformation of their cities. Each presentation was 7-minute long, with slides composed only of photos. The moderator gave a brief summary of the presentations after each of them, in Spanish or in English according to the language used by the speakers. A question period of 10 minutes ended the session.





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Recommendations that emerged from these discussions.	1. This event should be repeated in other forums since it showed real and concrete examples of interventions going on in different cities from 4 different continents. 2. It has been stressed that without real implementation examples, like these, the New Urban Agenda will remain a list of nice wishes. 3. It has been proposed to put forward these examples through UN Habitat documentation, completed with other examples coming from other cities around the world.
Partnerships or collaborations that emerged from the event.	1. Partnership between the 5 participant cities will go on through Metropolis, hopefully through UN Habitat. 2. Metropolis will take advantage of its international annual conference in Montreal, in June 2017, to reschedule the session, inviting these 5 partners and some more to present these of rebuilding the city
