DESCRIPTION	<p>The planning profession is undergoing a transition across the world. While many countries are struggling to adapt their old-fashioned master planning systems, others are experimenting with strategic planning, mega projects and an elimination of planning altogether. However, it is becoming evident that without sound planning, urbanization cannot be the engine of growth and sustainable development that it has the potential to be.</p> <p>This side event aims to explore how urban planners and other urban professionals can adapt to the new demands of integrated, multi-level planning being discussed in the New Urban Agenda; and to explore how planning education and research contribute to the capacity building of urban planners and evaluate the achievement of Habitat III agenda.</p>
