



DESCRIPTION	UN-Habitat has recently developed a set of new initiatives to position the agency as a key actor in the implementation and monitoring of the New Urban Agenda and the Sustainable Development Goals. This side event will briefly introduce some of these initiatives and exchange experiences from countries where they are being applied. These initiatives include the following: - City Prosperity Initiative. The CPI enables cities to identify opportunities and areas of intervention to become more prosperous. The CPI is a global monitoring mechanism, adaptable to national and local levels, that allows cities, countries, and the international community to measure progress. Its composite index made of six dimensions can support the formulation of evidence-based policies. The CPI has been applied in more than 300 cities across the world. - International Guidelines on Urban and Territorial Planning. The IG-UTP are designed to support reforms in planning processes and to reorient the content of plans. The guidelines contain recommendations for national government sub-national governments, civil society and planning professionals to incorporate IG-UTP principles into urban planning systems and adjust urban policies, plans and design in their contexts. - Housing at the Centre of the New Urban Agenda.
