Housing and urban policy interventions are highly country-specific given the various stages in which the transitional countries of Eastern Europe currently find themselves. East European countries with economies in transition face some common cousing challenges. including low energy efficiency tandards in housing; low housing affordability; underdeveloped rental markets; need for capacity development of decision makers, and lack of policy coordination between stakeholders at different evels.
