

Background information on Networking Event (themes, issues, context).	This networking event presented key elements of SLoCaT's Quito Action Plan for Sustainable Urban Mobility (QAPSUM), a global, open and transparent platform for all actors (e.g. transport industry, financial institutions, cities, academia, governments) which aims to transform urban mobility by contributing to safe, healthy, efficient, climate friendly and clean cities. QAPSUM is intended to deliver simultaneously on the New Urban Agenda (NUA), the Paris Agreement, and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.
Concise summary of the event proceedings, including key points discussed.	This event featured discussions of (a) potential contributions to QAPSUM by "non-traditional" transport stakeholders and those focusing on transport-relevant SDGs (e.g. youth, urban-rural linkages, road safety, energy efficiency, climate resilience); (b) how existing voluntary commitments on sustainable transport by non-state actors contribute; and (c) capacity building in support of the implementation of the transport elements of the NUA. Interventions by panelists were followed by audience questions.
