DESCRIPTION	<p>The number of Surabaya urban fire incidents in 2014 is 596 incidents, recorded as the most frequent fire incident in the last five years (Fire Brigade Agency, 2015). The number of fire incidents is still high with 325 incidents in 2015. In the last five years, the incidents have caused IDR 97.9 Billions damage losses, 36 fatalities and 125 injuries. The frequent and damaging fire hazard makes Surabaya in high-risk level of urban fire especially in kampung. Kampung with densely populated area, row houses with no gaps, narrow width of roads, dominated with semi-permanent houses and old buildings makes a very high level of vulnerability. Furthermore, the community understanding on fire risk and management is low. In consequently, making low risk kampung as part of urban resilience to fire can be initiated by collaborative planning. The collaborative planning has to involve many stakeholders, promote local wisdoms and seek the best options for kampung with its own special characteristics of urban landscape. Serial studies on urban fire in Nyamplungan Kampung brought by students and lecturers of Urban and Regional Planning Department – Institut Teknologi Sepuluh Nopember (ITS) will give the audiences the context of case study. The audiences will be invited to participate in enriching ideas on making a plan for low risk kampung via participatory mapping. In the end, the output of plan will be consulted back to the community to ensure the applicability of the plan in making a low risk kampung to urban fire.</p>
