Concise summary of Training Event, and the skills developed during the event.	The training was structured around several country and city case studies. The comprehensive key note focused on challenges of transformation processes in Germany. Core message was the call for an integrated and strategic urban development approach with strong multilevel-governance and participation elements. The key note was followed by city case studies from Ukraine (Kiev, Chernivtsi), Romania (Cluj) and Germany (Ludwigsburg). The case studies contributed to a sharing of experiences of cities and existing knowledge among practitioners on integrated urban development approaches and enabling framework conditions. They also assisted in identifying mutual partnerships by assessing not only common challenges but also the replicability of implementation-oriented planning tools to urban transformation in its multiple forms on city-wide as well as on neighbourhood level.
